The last day of school, **June 12th**, will not be a full day of school. Classes will be going to Mass together, the kindergarten class will graduate, fines will be collected, report cards will be passed out, small parties will be held in the classrooms, and then students will be dismissed. School will recess at 10:00 a.m. Please make sure that you arrange transportation for your child/ren on that day.

The school doors will open at 7:00 a.m. School dismissal will be at 2:20p.m. Buses will pull out at 2:25 p.m.

We will offer an after school care program from 10:25 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. If you are interested and have not yet registered, please call the school office.

As a reminder of driveway safety rules, the north driveway must be used to enter the playground and the south driveway to exit the playground. Please remember to watch for children and for other cars, this is especially important at 2:20 p.m. when picking children up. Children are running straight to their cars and are not watching or anticipating car movement. *A change this year. If you are walking your child/ren into the building, please park on the playground. The north side door will only be open for drop-offs.*

Enclosed you will also find a supply list. It is included for your shopping convenience. Student assignment books, student atlases, goggles, Spanish dictionaries, tote bags, computer bags, composition notebooks and Bibles will be available in the school office for those children needing one. The cost of school lunch will be \$2.70 this year. Applications for free and reduced cost of meals will be in the parent back to school folder that you receive on Monday, August 28th. If you qualify, please take advantage of this program.
